### **Hipéexnu'. Kii'u Nuun Wisiix**

Lapwai, Idaho. "Forever is in the Future"

Nimiipuu (Nez Perce dialect) language and culture program. Development of digital materials to teach and preserve Nimiipu language. Oral story lessons put to video.

### **Kingdom Workers**

Whiteriver, AZ. "DIY Home Repair" Workshops

Do it yourself workshops to teach how to weatherize homes and basic home repairs.

### **Native American Urban Ministry**

Phoenix, AZ. "Increasing Resiliency and Belonging in Elders"

Program for urban Native elders which include cultural and spiritual events, leadership and computer training, weekly social and support group, outings and mini workshops on healthcare, wellness, self-care, current events.

### **Native Search Solutions**

Mesa, AZ. "Technology Training for MMIP"

Planning grant to train tribal police in new technology and approach in solving MMIP.

### **River of Life Ministries**

Missoula, MT. "Mobile Food Pantry"

Mobile food pantry which will travel to Flathead Reservation and surrounding tribal communities.

### **Southside Presbyterian Church**

Tucson, AZ. "Educational Exhibits of Church's Tohono O'odham History"

Project will preserve, celebrate and educate members, the public on the history of the church through educational exhibits, audio/video recordings of elders. Original 30 members were O'odham, now has multi-racial membership.

### **St. John's Methodist Church**

Bridgeton, NJ. "Winter Gear and Tool Closet Program"

Program will provide winter gear, coats, gloves, hats, socks, etc. as well as a tool closet with shovels, salt, etc. for families to borrow.

### **Stop the Pain of Substance Abuse**

Maxton, N.C. "Sacred Hoop Talking Circle and Open Mic Nights"

Written expression articulated in a form of artistic expression and shared in a public forum at an "open mic" night, to share recovery stories. 1 year program facilitated by licensed counselors.
